The Ministry Leadership Program (MLP) is the bespoke, contemporary mission leadership formation program for senior leaders from across Catholic healthcare, aged care, education and social services.

It is a comprehensive, immersive adult learning experience that centres the diversity of the expertise and wisdom of its participants. It is a facilitated learning experience with input from experts in key areas of Catholic mission formation, including ethics, heritage and whole person care.

The MLP is the signature mission formation program of the Catholic sectors.

It represents significant value for money with content experts facilitating forum groups that support participants to embed their learnings in their own organisational context. All program costs, including overnight accommodation and meals, are included in the program fee.

Delivery

The MLP uses an immersive approach to formation. Eight sessions, a combination of face-to-face and online, take place over 15 months.
