# Bachelor of International Development Studies Teach-out Plan

# **Completion requirements**

To qualify for the degree, a student must complete 240 cp from the Schedule of Unit Offerings, consisting of:

1. 220 cp from specified units including:

- 80 cp from International Development Studies major (Part A)
- 10 cp from Community Development unit (Part B)
- 50 cp from Global Studies units (Part C)
- 40 cp from Arts Minor (Part D) **OR** 40 cp of electives from the Bachelor of Arts and/or Diploma in Languages units (Part E)
- 20 cp from Research Methods units (Part F)
- 20 cp from Fieldwork units (Part G) and

2. 20 cp from Core Curriculum units (Part H)

#### **Exit points**

Students who have met the requirements of the Diploma in Liberal Arts can exit with that award.
