Students enrolled in the Diploma in Educational Studies (Tertiary Preparation) may be part of this program because they did not meet the subject Entry Requirements for a Bachelor-level teaching qualification. Students can meet these outstanding Entry Requirements by completing one of ACU's Foundation Units.

Outstanding Entry Requirements for Mathematics or English will be met on the completion of a Foundation Unit as shown below.

As these units are exclusively used to meet Entry Requirements, EDMA111 and EDLA111 cannot be credited into a Bachelor-level teaching qualification after a future transfer.
