Accreditation to Teach in a Catholic School

1. Victoria

To be accredited to teach **any subject other than RE at a Catholic School** in Victoria will require the completion of:

 EDRE429: Foundation Studies Teaching in Catholic Schools (study this as one of your Education Elective Units)

However, to teach Religious Education in a Catholic School will require the completion of the following units either as electives or as part of the Theological Studies Teaching Area:

Note: You will **NOT** be required to complete EDRE429: Foundation Studies Teaching in Catholic Schools if you opt for the Religious Education Teaching Area.

2. New South Wales

To be accredited to teach **any subject other than RE at a Catholic School** in New South Wales, you will need to apply for accreditation through the Diocesan Education Office for your school's district. You won't need to do this until you know you will be teaching in a Catholic school.

However, to teach Religious Education in a Catholic School will require the completion of the following units either as electives or as part of the Studies of Religion Teaching Area:

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3. Queensland

To be accredited to teach **any subject other than RE at a Catholic School** in Queensland, you will need to apply for accreditation through the Catholic School Authority for your school's district. You won't need to do this until you know you will be teaching in a Catholic school.

However, to **teach Religious Education in a Catholic School** will require applying for accreditation through the Catholic School Authority for your school's district plus the completion of the following units as either electives or as part of the Studies of Religion or Theological Studies Teaching Area:
