Elective Information

Initial Teacher Education (ITE) courses at ACU are made up of a combination of compulsory and elective units. The 2018-2020 Bachelor of Education (ECP and B-5) programs have Elective options. Students may choose to use these in several ways, including:

- 1. To pursue further specialist knowledge in a special area of interest such as English and Literacy, Mathematics and Numeracy or Inclusive Education.
- 2. To broaden your general knowledge by studying a series of unrelated units from a range of Education and/or Arts topics you may choose from any of the units listed below, and any units offered by the National School of Arts.
- 3. Applying unspecified credit from previous study at a previous institution. This credit must be submitted via the Credit Application form (<u>Apply for credit</u>) and approved by the Course Coordinator.

If you have been granted Unspecified Credit for prior learning, this can replace one or more electives. Consult your Course Coordinator if you are unsure of how many electives you are required to complete.

National/Online Elective Units

Online elective units are available to students on all campuses. Please be aware Summer, Winter and Professional Term units may have limited places.

Units in non-standard study periods

Students should note that a five-week online program is the equivalent, each week, of over 7 hours lecture/tutorial/workshop and up to 20 hours of reading, assignment writing and other forms of engagement with content, peers, and staff. It approaches a full-time commitment over the teaching period.

Units that run on campus in Summer Term, Professional Term 1, Professional Term 2, Winter Term, or Professional Term 5 should be assumed to be an intensive, and the particular dates can be found <u>here</u>.
